- Investing students' leisure time In the practice of various activities, and the acquisition of skills, experience and knowledge related to sustainable development.

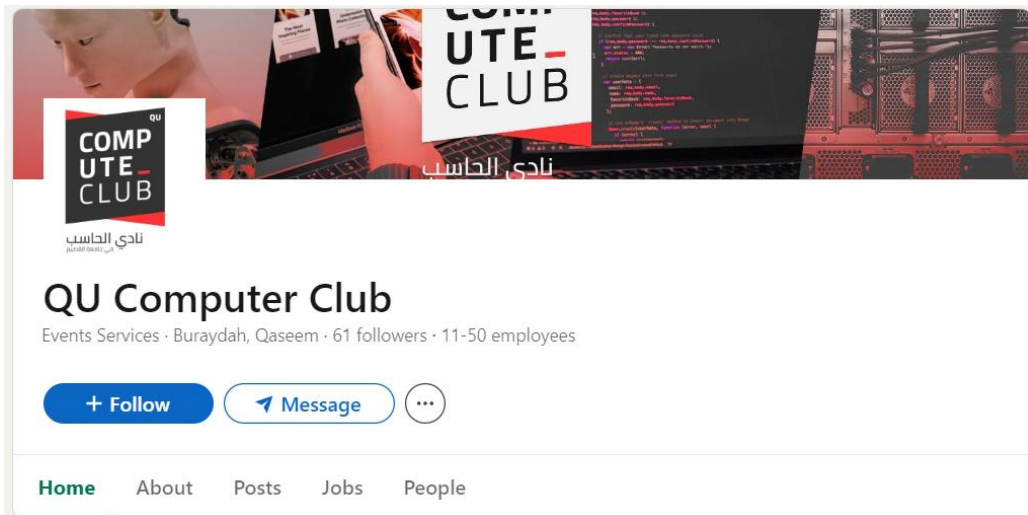

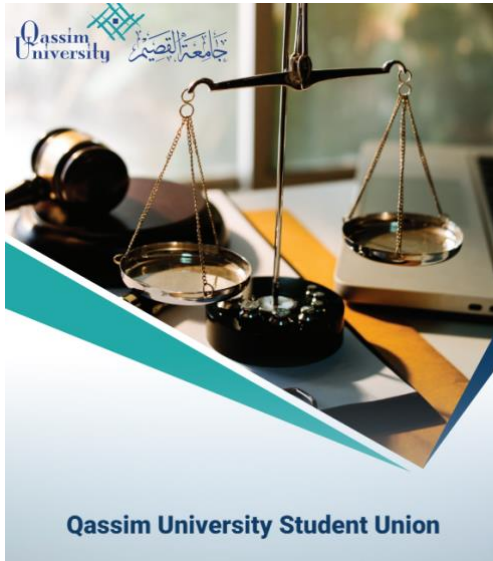
