His Royal Highness Prince Dr. Faisal bin Mishaal bin Saud bin Abdulaziz, Governor of Qassim Region, sponsored the "Second International Scientific Meeting for Camels" under the slogan "Camels 2024: Sustaining Heritage", organized by Qassim University represented by the College of Veterinary Medicine, in conjunction with the Year of Camels 2024, in partnership with the Emirate of Qassim Region and the branch of the Ministry of Environment, Water and Agriculture in Qassim, on Sunday, October 3, 2024, which lasts for two days, in the presence of His Excellency the President of the University, Prof. Dr. Muhammad bin Fahd Al-Sharekh, and the university's vice-rectors. And heads of government agencies, with the participation of 20 local and international speakers and a group of specialists in the field of camels from 6 countries, at the Conference Center in the University City.

His Highness also witnessed the paragraphs of the ceremony, starting with the Holy Quran and the royal anthem, and watched a visual presentation talking about the Kingdom's interest in camels, and the university's efforts, in addition to introducing the meeting in its second edition, which aims to introduce the latest scientific and research developments in the fields of camel health, diseases and economics locally and internationally, in order to contribute to the development of this important economic wealth and to support the Kingdom's Vision 2030, as well as determining the nature and size of health problems facing investment in the camel sector, and developing plans and scientific recommendations to treat them.

After that, His Highness the Governor of Qassim Region was briefed on the accompanying exhibition, which contains 20 corners, including a corner for the College of Veterinary Medicine, the College of Agriculture and Food, the University Veterinary Hospital, and a number of participating entities and companies to display veterinary products and devices and guidance publications in the field of camels and their care, as well as toured the scientific poster exhibition with the participation of 53 scientific posters for faculty members and students interested in this field, and at the end of the celebration, His Highness honored the sponsors and partners of the organization.

During his patronage of the meeting, His Highness the Emir of the region directed the establishment of a comprehensive scientific center for camel research, to be one of the first centers at the level of Saudi universities, and to be a reliable scientific reference specialized in the field of camel research, and focuses on studying the various aspects related to camels, from the environmental, veterinary and health aspects, in addition to developing camel breeding practices, improving their breeds and reducing tampering with camels, as well as providing advanced studies and research that keep pace

with the aspirations of the wise leadership and contribute to achieving the Kingdom's Vision 2030, which pays great attention to heritage. National and for the development of various sectors.

His Highness pointed out that the center will have close cooperation with a number of concerned authorities, most notably the Camel Club and the Ministry of Environment, Water and Agriculture, with the aim of enhancing national efforts in preserving the cultural and developmental heritage associated with camels, supporting farmers and breeders by providing them with the latest research and technologies, promoting scientific research in this field, and to be a scientific beacon that serves future generations and supports efforts to develop the camel sector.

His Highness the Prince of Qassim stressed that the university's launch of a postgraduate program to detect tampering with camels, and the launch of the camel center, will make this university a pioneer and unique scientific center for camel research at the level of universities in the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia, appreciating the university's efforts to hold this meeting, which he recalled with him the past days when he attended in 1427 the first meeting, pointing out that holding it was an initiative that is the first of its kind at a time when there was no interest in camel science.

His Highness said: I was not surprised at the university, led by Prof. Dr. Muhammad bin Fahd Al-Sharekh, and all the colleagues who organized such a meeting to complement the past efforts, asking God Almighty to help them in everything related to camel research, and to cooperate with all concerned authorities, whether in the camel club or in the Ministry of Environment, Water and Agriculture, and all parties interested in this matter in order to serve this heritage on the occasion of the Year of the Camels, and to be hopefully Almighty the best help for everyone who cares about the affairs of Camels.

For his part, His Excellency the Dean of the College of Veterinary Medicine, Dr. Yousef Al-Saedi, Chairman of the Organizing Committee, stressed that organizing this meeting comes within a series of scientific initiatives and activities at the university, based on its mission and strategic objectives towards promoting research and development, exchanging knowledge between researchers, stimulating innovation, and building scientific networks between various researchers and scientific institutions, which enhances its contribution to the scientific community locally and internationally.

He added: Today, we highlight in the sessions of this meeting the camels as an important heritage that draws conscience for development, development, understanding what is new and unique, and coming up with recommendations that contribute to the development of this field for the benefit of humanity, in response to the directions of our wise leadership, supported by God, and in light of the unlimited national support from the rulers, may God protect and protect them, and as a contribution to national development, in conjunction with the Year of Camels 2024.

Al-Saedi explained that this meeting, which includes a group of scientists, expertise and cadres working in the fields of camels, with whom we meet to discuss and study, through 20 speakers and 53 scientific posters, and this meeting also covers 6 main objectives and axes of the most important economic and social challenges facing the camel sector, distributed over eight scientific sessions over two days, to discuss recent developments in the diagnosis of camel diseases and detection of tampering, modern techniques in camel breeding, international, clinical and surgical interventions in camels, as well as technology Camel products manufacturing and safety, camel breeding and care, and the socio-economic challenges they face.

He added: One of the most prominent achievements of this meeting is the announcement of a graduate program concerned with detecting tampering and cheating in camels, and also includes a scientific center specialized in detecting manifestations of tampering and cheating in camels that contributes to the rehabilitation and graduation of specialists in detecting the wrong practices to which this important heritage is exposed, and exercises the role of education and awareness in combating this tampering, stressing that this program and that center are two unique achievements that distinguish the university internationally as it is the first university ever to launch An academic program and a specialized scientific center concerned with combating tampering and cheating with camels because of its important economic and development dimensions.

Al-Saedi also thanked and appreciated His Highness the Emir of the region for his support and sponsorship of this forum, which comes under his guidance, as well as thanked His Excellency the President of the University for his support and follow-up, the university's vice-rectors and all its entities, the organizational and scientific committees, the organization's partners and sponsors, asking God Almighty that this forum achieves its goals and aspirations.
