The University has many facilities, including but not limited to the following:

- Faculties, including laboratories, workshops, lecture halls and office rooms for university employees, both in the University dorms in Milidah or in the other branches.
- Buildings of senior management and buildings for deanships and departments.
- Library building and branch libraries that provide services to all employees of the university.
- The University Hospital Building, an integral medical facility that is part of the Medical City in the University City in Milidah, which will provide services to University employees and the community members, in addition to the general and specialized medical clinics currently operating, which provide health care services for all university staff including students, faculty and staff.
- A residential city for students with integrated service facilities such as restaurants, prayer rooms, dining rooms, resting and break rooms.
- University housing for faculty members.
- Sports City, which includes a range of facilities and cultural, social and sports facilities implemented using new modern designs and provides a full range of playgrounds and services for employees of the university students and faculty members and staff.

This set includes:

- o Bowling hall and recreational games (billiards, baby foot and).
- o Multiple games gym (football, basketball, volleyball, badminton and).
- o Services Building (for management, bathrooms, dressing rooms,).
- o Swimming pool building with public terraces and equipped for tournaments.
- o Social building equipped with social rooms and cafeteria.
- o A group of outdoor stadiums for playing football, basketball and tennis.

The total area of these facilities is (89800 m2) and it costed 89 million Saudi riyals, and built using the latest models of construction and equipped on a high level to serve the employees of the Qassim University Deanship of Student Affairs.

Rationalization of the use of facilities at the University is organized through a mechanism of several stages, and can be listed as follows:

The First Stage: the stage of examining the applications and making sure that whatever

is requested is not already present in the university.

The Second Stage: Continuous work to rationalize the use of facilities. The facilities management at the University has an important role in the organization and rationalization of the use of university facilities, in accordance with the functions of the facilities management mentioned above.

With the aim of rationalization and effective use, the university and colleges assign management of their farms, laboratories, medical clinics and sports and cultural facilities to specialized departments, including administrative and technical leaders, in order to rationalize and ensure efficient management and use of all the facilities. The university is also keen to utilize the university facilities such as laboratories and quality halls, etc., to make the best use of these facilities and to disseminate them, and to regulate the use of these facilities and equipment by all university employees and external bodies through agreements that achieve financial return. The university is also guiding the spending process with economic plans to provide equipment through alternatives to the process of procurement such as leasing and implementation of services such as landscaping, cleaning and transport by contracting with specialized companies.

The Third Stage: training the users of the equipment in order to achieve the maximum benefit from this equipment. The University concludes all contracts for supplying equipment, on a condition that the supplier will provide training sessions on how to use and operate the equipment to those who will be using the equipment in the university.

In addition to the above requirements obligated on the suppliers for providing training on their equipment, the academic sequence system enables colleges to arrange for the experienced professors to convey their expertise and train the staff assisting faculty members and new faculty members on the use of equipment from laboratories and others, through lectures and joint classroom activities.

The University shall establish regulations for the use of facilities, including:

- Some facilities are limited to the use of some university employees.
- Some utilities use time controls.
- Some facilities are used with financial controls.
- Some facilities are available to all university staff

Lending and beneficiary services section

Lending is defined as the process of recording sources of information for use outside the library or information center for a specified period of time, and lending is one of the most important services provided by libraries to the beneficiaries, and by which the effectiveness of the library is measured and often supervised by an employee who records the material before taking it out to the borrower and confirming it in the event of return it by the beneficiary, and thus follows the self-automated lending service so that the user can register books or renew the loan himself without referring to the competent employee in the library.

Loan and beneficiary service functions

1- Taking out the loaned material requested by the beneficiary outside the library to read it at his home or elsewhere.

2- Renewal of borrowed materials that have expired and are still needed by the rasing, usually allows the deanship to renew the book itself once, and the renewal service can be done via the Internet.

3- Book books when they are returned to some beneficiaries who are in urgent need of them.

4- Follow up on the delayed materials and remind the those who are hired to do so by contacting them by telephone.

5- Respond to the inquiries of visitors to the library from students and researchers by telephone or when visiting directly.

6- Printing extracts from automated indexes from the library database.

7- Introducing the beneficiaries to the best way to search the automated indexes.

8- Introducing new students to the facilities of the Central Library and the special regulations and regulations and services provided by the library.

Indexing and classification section

The aim of indexing is to try to control human knowledge and present it in a prescribed and orderly manner to scholars and researchers so that it can be used.

The indexing department performs the technical procedures of the information vessels acquired by the library, from the indexing, classification and automatic recording of vessels. Using dewey decimal classification system, Anglo-American indexing rules.

Department of University Letters and Manuscripts

This section seeks to develop university letters and manuscripts at the university **in order to facilitate the researchers faculty, graduate students and the public community what they need in this regard, as well as to trace manuscripts and documents located in the region and deposit them in the university**, the number of university letters available in the section amounted to about (1600) messages on CD discs in Arabic and about (400) scientific messages in English and the number of original manuscripts 40 and about (3000) pictorial manuscripts and obtained (20) photo documents From local documents.

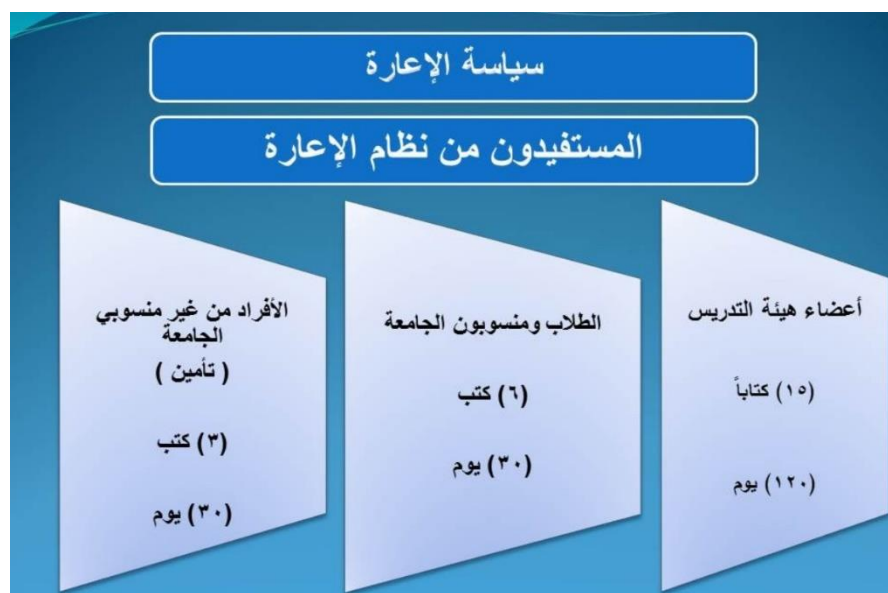

The activities of the summer club vary to include six tracks: the skill track, which aims to develop the participants' skills in calligraphy, drawing, photography and some manual skills, the educational track, which aims to add educational experiences to the participants, the technical track, which aims to provide participants with the basics of programming and application making, in addition to the entertainment track, which contains recreational programs and games offered to the club's participants, as well as the competitions track such as the club's general competitions, the "Who is the Martyr" competition, the major cultural competition, as well as the general programs track. Which targets club participants and others.

For his part, the Dean of Student Affairs and Executive Director of the Summer Club, Dr. Muhammad Al-Ajlan, confirmed that the number of registered male and female students in the club is witnessing a significant increase day by day, adding that the work system within the club is divided into a number of groups, each group has a supervisor and a trainer who move between several programs daily accompanied by members, and in at least three rooms through distance learning programs, where activities are divided between young men and women according to ages.

Al-Ajlan explained that the university's belief in its societal role towards activating the energies of all youth groups, whether male or female, resulted in investing these energies during the summer vacation, wishing success and success to the club's members and that its activities and programs would benefit those registered in it from all levels of education.

The University's Veterinary Hospital holds a training course in cooperation with the Camel Club to "Detect Tamper"

To complement the fruitful cooperation between the two sides, the university, represented by the University Veterinary Hospital, in cooperation with the Camel Club, is organizing a training course to detect tampering with camels over a full month, starting from the first of Muharram 1443 AH, at the headquarters of the University Veterinary Hospital in order to raise the efficiency of veterinarians about the different methods in camels and methods of detecting them outwardly and using clinically and laboratory-advanced devices.

For his part, Dr. Abdullah Al-Hawas, Director of the Veterinary Hospital at the University, confirmed that the participants in this course are expected to acquire the ability to familiarize themselves with the different methods used to tamper with camels and different injection places, and they will also have the ability to evaluate them and identify infectious diseases that are similar to tampering with tampering and how to differentiate between them.

Al-Hawas added that the trainee will also learn about the negative effects of hormonal injections and how to detect them, as well as familiarity with how ultrasound works and how to use them in examining healthy tissue and detecting tampering in camels, in addition to learning about the way the thermal camera works, the work of the X-ray machine, and laboratory devices.

The University Holds a Training Course to Raise the Efficiency of Veterinarians in Detecting Tampering in Cooperation with the Camel Club
